

## SUSTAINABLE ENERGY ACCESS FOR THE LATIN AMERICA - CARIBBEAN REGION

This initiative, funded by the [Canadian](#) government and implemented by the [Latin American Energy Organization \(OLADE\)](#) aims to enhance access to sustainable and affordable energy needed to promote economic growth in Latin America and the Caribbean (LAC). It will improve the capacity for energy planning and regulation across the countries in the region and reinforce corporate social responsibility in the energy sector.
